PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Faith-Based Academics

Students will take four courses per semester with the goal of graduating with a Link Postsecondary Program Certificate of Professional Readiness. These include:

Link Courses: These courses teach students skills like employability, independent living, and self-advocacy.

Elective Courses: These courses are done alongside traditional SEU students to build friendships and create an environment of encouragement. Course syllabi may be modified to fit each student’s needs.

Courses for Credit: Students who demonstrate the ability to do so may enroll in courses for credit in their second year.

Credential Courses: Upon graduation, students will receive a Link Program Certificate of Professional Readiness, as well as a credential in their chosen field. Students may choose from Education, Fitness, Business & Retail, Art & Design, or Tourism & Hospitality.

Job Skills Training

Courses and work experiences provide opportunities for students to develop employment skills and add to their resumes. Each student will complete 3 internships, which are available both on-and off-campus.

Caring Staff & Faculty

Our Link staff and SEU faculty are dedicated to providing all Link students both the academic support they need and the confidence to succeed.

Collegiate Experience & Community Integration

Link students build friendships with peers, mentors, staff, and faculty, while enjoying access to all SEU resources, activities, and events. Our caring community gives Link students many opportunities to become involved, and to thrive, connect, and engage.

Inclusive Living Experience

Link students live in campus housing and are paired with a trained residential peer mentor as a roommate.
